



DAILY HEALTH SCREENING

All participants of the 2021 Canadian Track Championships (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, event staff) are required to complete a daily COVID-19 self-screening questionnaire before arriving on-site via [HealthQ](#), which will also require name and contact information for contact tracing purposes. If a participant has failed their daily health screening, they will see a Red Screen and should not enter the facility. The information and next steps will be instructed from there and emailed to the participant and the Odyssey Medical Health & Safety Team.

VENUE ACCESS & PROOF OF VACCINATION

Proof of full vaccination, as outlined [in this link](#), for **all** participants and attendees (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, event staff, spectators, sponsors) will be required upon entering the Mattamy National Cycling Centre. Please have your [proof of vaccination](#) ready to show prior to entering the facility at the *Community Entrance* and be prepared for potential wait times. ***Any participant or attendee leaving the venue will have to show proof of vaccination upon each entry.***

For out of province participants, proof of vaccination requires the identification of your vaccination receipt that would include your name, date of birth, date of vaccination, along with a piece of photo identification. Note that a provincial QR code that is not issued from the Province of Ontario will not be accepted unless it is presented with the above-mentioned information.

NEW: Entrance for Officials, Volunteers & Event Staff

A secondary entrance will be arranged for the duration of this event only. This entrance will be the ***Emergency Exit Door***, located between the *Community Entrance* and *Loading Entrance*, and it will only be available for specified timeslots. MASK MANDATE & PHYSICAL DISTANCING

All participants are required to wear a mask (covering their nose and mouth) at all times inside the Mattamy National Cycling Centre, with the following exceptions:

- When any person is eating or drinking;
- Athletes who are going up to the track to race; or
- Athletes that are riding on their rollers or trainers.

Knowing that physical distancing of 2m cannot be respected at all times, we do ask that an effort be made as much as possible. If athletes and/or coaches are interacting with officials, volunteers, or event staff on the infield, please be masked and distanced. There will be floor markings in key areas, including but not limited to the sport information desk (riders confirmation), bike check, and podium.

SPECTATORS

Spectators will not have access to the infield at any point and must remain on the 3rd floor of the velodrome. Please respect physical distancing and avoid the first few rows of seating near the track.



VOLUNTEER AREA

The volunteer area will be in the "Sport D". This will hold the food for all officials, volunteers, and event staff. Tables will be spread apart, and we ask that volunteers physical distance themselves when eating or drinking. Individual hand sanitizers, masks and gloves will be readily available.

CLEANING PROCEDURES & SANITIZING STATIONS

There will be frequent cleaning of high-touch surfaces, including the upper rail of the track between races and regularly used bike racks. Various sanitizing stations will be located throughout the venue and in the infield at key locations:

- Entrance to the track (2)
- Commissaire Platform
- Sport Information Desk (*disposable masks and gloves will be readily available if needed*)
- Volunteer Area
- Bike Check
- Podium

BIKE CHECK

Anyone that will be handling the bikes should sanitize before and after doing so. Officials and volunteers will be supplied with gloves to perform their duties. Physical distancing of 2m must be respected while the inspection is underway.

TEAM PITS & ROLLERS/TRAINERS SET UP

Team pits will be placed into single rows and spread throughout the infield, allowing for maximized space and flow. No pits will be placed back-to-back with another, allowing the team from that pit to set up rollers and trainers directly behind their dedicated pit.

If rollers and trainers need to be set up elsewhere, please be mindful and cautious of other teams in the area to make an effort of respecting physical distancing. Tape will be made available at the Sport Information Desk mark off your team's area.

AWARDS CEREMONIES

All awards ceremonies will be conducted in a **self-serve** manner. Masked event staff will place the medals and jersey on the table beside the podium (left side when looking at the podium). The masked athletes will grab their award from the table and proceed onto the podium. After pictures have been taken, athletes exit the podium to their left-hand side while event staff re-stock the table for the next ceremony.

We ask that those watching the ceremony please stay 2m apart from others. Either stanchions or tape will be marked on the ground to allow a clear visual for event photographers to capture each podium presentation.

Any participant that does not comply with these rules will first be asked to correct their behaviour. A second verbal warning will be given before being asked to leave the event if the behaviour persists.
Riders will lose their race bibs and not be allowed to start.
