Event Rules/Licenses:

UCI Regulations and CC specific regulations will be enforced for all Canada Cup Categories.

Valid UCI international licenses are required for Canada Cup UCI categories (Jr/Elite Men & Jr/Elite Women). Holders of UCI international licenses that do not bear a photograph will be required to present an approved and valid government photo ID in addition to their UCI license.

Day Licenses

If you DO NOT hold a current CCA/UCI Race Licence or Cycling BC Provincial Race License, insurance is required.

- \$5.00 YOUTH 16 & under (DOB after January 1, 2005)
- \$12.00 JUNIOR & ADULT 17 & over (DOB before December 31, 2004)
- \$15.00 OUT-OF-COUNTRY FOREIGN RIDER

Foreign Riders must sign a declaration that adequate out-of-country medical insurance has been obtained and have a race license from their own country of residence. UCI Elite and Junior categories must register a minimum of 48 hours before the event.

Race Package Pick-up:

Package pick-up will be available at the registration office from Monday July 19th at 5pm MST. Tuesday from 9:00 till 14:00 & Wednesday from 9:00 till 10:00 MST.

Race packages can be picked up by the rider or a representative; however, the riders UCI Licence must be presented to pick up the package. If the package is being picked up by a representative, they must have a valid UCI Licence.

Training Periods:

The course will be open to racers only during designated official Training times. During these times bike plates are mandatory. Staff can obtain bike plates from the registration by presenting a valid UCI Licence. Failure to run a bike plate during official training periods will result in disqualification or fine from UCI.

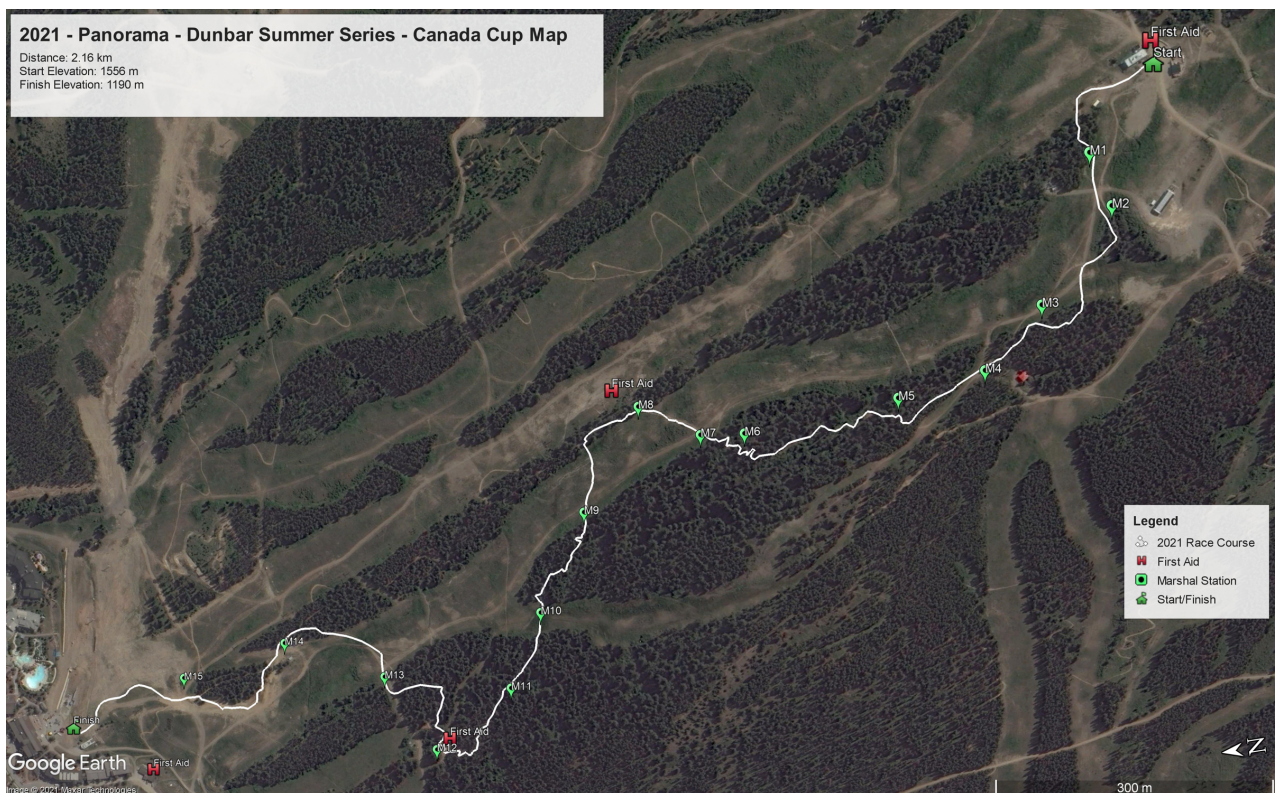
Venue Information

By Car

Panorama is situated in BC’s Purcell Mountains, with alpine views to the Rocky Mountains. The nearest major city is Calgary, AB, just a 3½ hour drive away. Access from Calgary is west, via Highway 1 through the Banff and Kootenay National Parks, followed by a turn south on Highway 93 through to Radium and onwards to Invermere, BC.

From Invermere, a gentle 20-minute drive rises into the Purcell Mountains and winds towards Panorama Mountain Resort.

Air Access

All the nearest airports are listed on the map.

- Calgary International Airport (YYC) is the most common access point to Panorama. It is 311 km from Panorama through the world-famous Banff and Kootenay National Parks. During the winter season we offer airport transfers from YYC.
- Canadian Rockies International Airport (YXC) in Cranbrook, BC is just 161 km from Panorama.
