The Canada Cup series is designed to provide competitive opportunities to the next generation of cyclists, transitioning from provincial race series to international competitions.

The celebrated BC Cup is collective of events forming Canada’s premier downhill racing series. The 2023 BC Cup Downhill Serie will play out over a series of races throughout the Province, giving racers the chance to accumulate points from May to September, chasing the opportunity to ultimately be crowned the BC Cup DH Series winner.

[UCI regulations](#) and [CC specific regulations](#) will be enforced for all Canada Cup Categories. Cycling BC [CyclingBC Race Rules](#) will be enforced for all other categories.

Valid UCI international licenses are required for all Canada Cup, BC Cup and BC Championship categories. Holders of UCI international licenses that do not bear a photograph will be required to present an approved and valid government photo ID in addition to their UCI license.

The series is open to all individual riders with a valid UCI license in the Junior and Elite category.

Prizing: Canada Cup Categories

- All riders must finish their race to receive Canada Cup points
- Top five (5) athletes in each Elite Canada Cup category will be presented at the official award ceremonies
- Riders must wear clean cycling clothes or official team/sponsor casual clothes (bottom and top part) for the awards ceremony.
- Failure to comply will result in the loss of award (including prize money)
- UCI points will be awarded in accordance with the level of sanction for Junior/Elite DHI. - All athletes who have placed lower than 5th place, but that are still entitled for prizes in accordance with the prize money awarded by the race, must collect their prizes after the award ceremonies. *Failure to comply, with no pre-notification, will result in the loss of prizes (including prize money)*
- The Canada Cup leader jersey will be distributed at the award ceremonies by the Chief Commissaire or the Technical Delegate.

NOTE: The above prize money will be awarded to the UCI Elite Men's & Women's categories as per 2019 UCI Financial Obligations. UCI points and prize money are combined for Elite & Junior Expert categories, therefore any Junior Expert finishing within the top 8 of Elite times will receive UCI prize money accordingly.

RACE PACKAGE PICK-UP | DISTRIBUTION DE PAQUETS DE COURSE

Package pick-up will be available at the Guest Services Office on July 7th-9th (see schedule). Race packages can be picked up by the rider or a representative; however, the rider's UCI licence must be presented to pick up the package. If the package is being picked up by a representative, they must have a valid UCI Licence. See the full weekend schedule below for Race Office hours of operation.

START ORDER | APPEL DES COUREURS

Start order will follow the order set forth by the UCI and Canada Cup Regulations. (See below.)

1. All riders on the current UCI ranking

2. All riders on the current Canada Cup ranking
Tous les coureurs au classement Coupe Canada en date
3. Determine random order by plate numbers distributed
Ordre déterminé au hasard selon les numéros de plaques distribués

A minimum of 1 minute interval between two riders will apply for the top 10 Junior/Elite women and the top 20 Junior/Elite men in the current ranking.
Un intervalle d'au moins 1 minute entre deux coureurs sera appliqué pour le top 10 au classement en date des Junior/Elite femme et le top 20 du classement en date pour les Junior/Elite homme.

The start order for the first race of the season will be based on the reverse order of the current UCI ranking and the previous year's final Canada Cup Ranking.

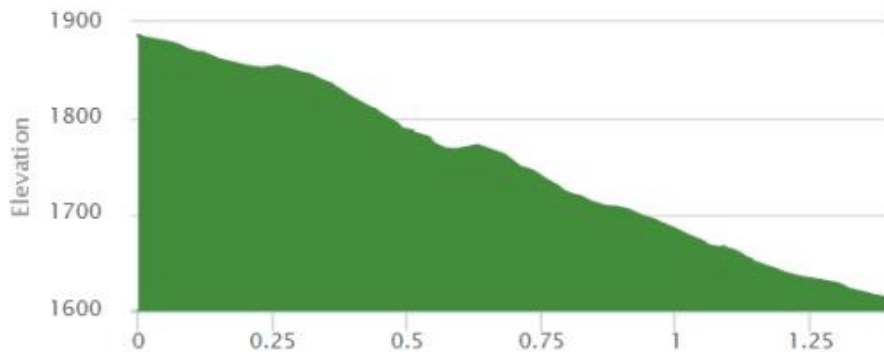
