Early bird entry fee ends on June 16th, normal registration fee from June 17th to June 21st.

There will be no day-of registrations. Online registration will close at the very latest at 5:00 pm local time, Friday June 21st. Past that deadline, a fine of \$50 CDN will be charged by Cycling Canada on top of the registration fee.

Refund Policy Refund: (subject to an administrative fee) available if cancellation request received by June 21, 2024 10:00am PST. No refunds after this time, even in the case of injury or mechanical problems.

EVENT RULES

<u>UCI regulations</u> and <u>CC-specific regulations</u> will be enforced for all Canada Cup Categories. The *applicable Cycling BC* regulations will be enforced for all other categories.

A BC Provincial License is valid for all **non-Canada Cup** categories.

Valid UCI international licenses are required for all U17 Expert, U19 Expert and U23/Elite riders. Holders of UCI international licenses that do not bear a photograph will be required to present an approved and valid government photo ID in addition to their UCI license.

The series is open to all individual riders with a valid UCI license in the U17 Expert, Junior Expert and U23/Elite category. U17 Expert and Junior Expert riders must possess a UCI Racing License with the "Expert" ability designation, or the highest available designation in their issuing province/territory/country.

UCI JUNIOR SERIES CATEGORY

UCI Junior Series Category

Please see the below entry criteria for the UCI Junior Series event, as mandated by the UCI. The full UCI Junior Series Criteria can be found <u>here</u>.

Canadian-licensed riders	Riders who possess a license issued in Canada will need to meet the following criteria: – Must hold a UCI Junior License, with the "Expert" ability designation
Non-Canadian Licensed riders	 Riders licensed outside of Canada will need to meet the following criteria, as mandated by the UCI: Must hold a UCI Junior License; Must have at least 20 UCI points (for riders in Europe) or 1 UCI point (for riders outside of Europe) in the latest UCI XCO individual junior ranking; <u>or</u> Must have been entered by their National Federation (maximum of 5 supplementary riders per category) Belong to a UCI elite MTB team or a UCI MTB team

PRIZES/POINTS

UCI Prize money and points will be awarded as per the 2023 UCI regulations and <u>2024 UCI Financial</u> <u>Obligations (see table below)</u>.

Canada Cup Series points and prize purse will be awarded as outlined in the <u>Canada Cup Series</u> <u>Regulations</u> and 2024 Organizer Financial and Competition Requirements. (See tables below.)

RACE PACKAGE PICK-UP

Package pick-up will be available at the registration desk on *Friday June 21 from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm and Saturday June 24 8:00 am to 10:00 am* (see schedule). Race packages can be picked up by the rider or a representative; however, the rider's UCI license must be presented to pick up the package. If the package is being picked up by a representative, they must have a valid UCI license.

Whistler Blackcomb event waivers need to be signed before race plate is collect.

Rider call-ups will follow the order set forth by the UCI and Canada Cup Regulations. (See below.)

<u>U17 (CC)</u>

- 1. Top 16 of the current Canada Cup Ranking
- 2. Random order by plate number distributed

Junior (CC)

- 1. Top 16 of the current Canada Cup Ranking
- 2. Random order by plate number distributed

Junior (Junior Series)

- 1. All riders on the current UCI ranking
- 2. Unclassified riders by rotation: The start order of the riders within the team must be confirmed by the teams during the rider's confirmation. The start order among the teams is determined as follows:
 - First, national teams whose order is determined by the nations' classification of the concerned category from the most recent world championships.
 - Second, unclassified national teams whose order is determined by drawing lots.
 - Third, UCI Elite Mountain Bike teams whose order is determined by the most recent team ranking.
 - Last, UCI Mountain Bike teams whose order is determined by the most recent team ranking.

The teams (in the order as mentioned above) are taken in turn with the teams' first riders starting in sequence, then the teams' second riders etc.

- 4. Random order by plate numbers distributed

Junior (UCI)

- 1. All riders on the current UCI ranking
- 2. Top 16 of the current Canada Cup Ranking
- 3. Random order by plate number distributed

U23/Elite (W/F & M/H)

- 1. All riders on the current UCI ranking
- 2. All riders on the current Canada Cup Ranking
- 3. Random order by plate number distributed




