Valid UCI international licenses are required for all Canada Cup, BC Cup and BC Championship categories. Holders of UCI international licenses that do not bear a photograph will be required to present an approved and valid government photo ID in addition to their UCI license.

The series is open to all individual riders with a valid UCI license in the Junior and Elite category.

Prizing: Canada Cup Categories

- All riders must finish their race to receive Canada Cup points
- Top five (5) athletes in each Elite Canada Cup category will be presented at the official award ceremonies
- Riders must wear clean cycling clothes or official team/sponsor casual clothes (bottom and top part) for the awards ceremony.
- Failure to comply will result in the loss of award (including prize money)
- UCI points will be awarded in accordance with the level of sanction for Junior/Elite DHI. - All athletes who have placed lower than 5th place, but that are still entitled for prizes in accordance with the prize money awarded by the race, must collect their prizes after the award ceremonies. *Failure to comply, with no pre-notification, will result in the loss of prizes (including prize money)*



- The Canada Cup leader jersey will be distributed at the award ceremonies by the Chief Commissaire or the Technical Delegate.

NOTE: The above prize money will be awarded to the UCI Elite Men’s & Women’s categories as per 2019 UCI Financial Obligations. UCI points and prize money are combined for Elite & Junior Expert categories, therefore any Junior Expert finishing within the top 8 of Elite times will receive UCI prize money accordingly.

RACE PACKAGE PICK-UP | DISTRIBUTION DE PAQUETS DE COURSE

Package pick-up will be available at the registration office on *August 2nd – 4th* (see schedule). Race packages can be picked up by the rider or a representative; however, the rider’s UCI licence must be presented to pick up the package. If the package is being picked up by a representative, they must have a valid UCI Licence. See the full weekend schedule below for Race Office hours of operation.

A minimum of 1 minute interval between two riders will apply for the top 10 Junior/Elite women and the top 20 Junior/Elite men in the current ranking.

Un intervalle d'au moins 1 minute entre deux coureurs sera appliqué pour le top 10 au classement en date des Junior/Elite femme et le top 20 du classement en date pour les Junior/Elite homme.

The start order for the first race of the season will be based on the reverse order of the current UCI ranking and the previous year's final Canada Cup Ranking.

The start order for U17 women will be ran in reverse order based on seeding results where the rider with the fastest time complete their run first and so on.

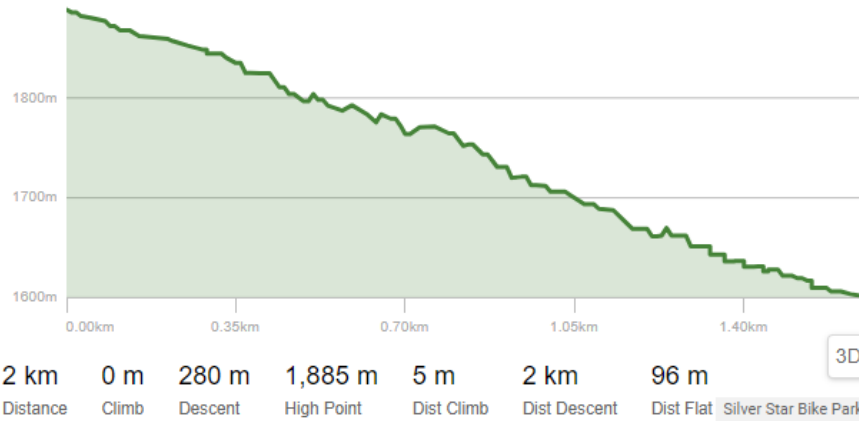
